**KU Libraries and U.S. Government Information:**

The KU Libraries provide several information resources that may be of interest to Haskell University students. All resources are available on-site in KU Libraries.

**U.S. Federal Government Publications:** KU Libraries are participants in the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) and have been since 1869. As such, our collections contain numerous publications and other information resources created by the Federal Government. These include the Congressional Record, Congressional committee reports and hearings, materials from federal agencies, and more. Many materials from 1976 onward are findable using the library online catalog. In addition, many publications from the mid-1990's onward are available both in paper as well as electronically, with links to electronic files located in the online catalog records.

**Open CRS:** A collaborative project to provide public access to Congressional Research Service Reports created by CRS researchers for Congress. OpenCRS is listed in KU Libraries Web Resources and is also available directly at <http://www.opencrs.net>

**KU Libraries Licensed Resources** – available from the KU Libraries main page, under Information Gateway - 'Databases', in alphabetical list or in subject groupings.

**CQ (Congressional Quarterly) Electronic Library** - a number of CQ Press-produced resources including CQ Weekly, CQ Researcher, the Washington Information Directory, and specialized collections on Congress, Supreme Court, and more.

**Historical Statistics of the United States** – A quantitative view of American History covering Population; Work and Welfare; Economic Structure and Performance; Economic Sectors; and, Governance and International Relations. Topics are placed in historical context by accompanying essays. View, print, or download statistical tables, graphs, datasets and essays.

**Lexis-Nexis Academic** - Provides access to: full-text of current news and up to the last 20 years; full-text federal, state & international legal materials.

**Lexis-Nexis Congressional** - comprehensive access to U.S. legislative information, including congressional publications and documents, statistics, current members of Congress and congressional committees, and regulatory and statutory information. Most publications listed will be available from the KU Libraries collection.

**National Journal Group's Policy Central** - A comprehensive online resource on politics and policy. Policy Central includes selective full-text access to several distinct journals, including: National Journal online & CongressDaily.

**Policy File** - Provides online access to abstracts and if available, links to full-text articles on public policy research and analysis from think tanks, university research programs, research organizations and publishers.

**Public Documents Masterfile** - A comprehensive electronic guide to federal, state, local and international public documents spanning over 200 years of publication, in a single searchable database.
