Goals/Resolutions

1. Work toward a more formal organization and structure for the Consortium including:
  - a. Create consortium website (Geoff).
    - i. Beta version completed by Nov. 1.
  - b. Adopt a new name for the consortium (Cathy).
    - i. Discussion over e-mail
    - ii. Nominations by Nov. 1
  - c. Explore possibility of expanding consortium. Potential new members include:
    - i. U of Wisconsin
    - ii. U. of Iowa
    - iii. U. of Minnesota
    - iv. Indiana University
    - v. Chicago University
2. Explore collaborative projects
  - a. Discussion over e-mail
3. Work together to negotiate consortia prices for subscriptions to electronic databases:
  - a. INION
    - i. Contact RLG and find out what's going on with INION (Jon)
    - ii. Contact OCLC to find out their intention for the INION database (Janet)
    - iii. Consider EV as backup in case OCLC drops or charges too much.
  - b. CEEOL
    - i. Consortium pricing, limited access.
  - c. ABSEES
    - i. Consider EV as backup in case Ebsco gets too expensive
4. Support the model of preservation through microfilm and use through digital versions of the microfilm (policy statement on website)
5. Work to collect regional materials collaboratively
  - a. Compile collection and curriculum profiles for each library (Jon & Andy)
  - b. Divide up collection responsibilities as equitably as possible
