

In preparation for the library orientation session on Aug 31 in Watson 419, please do the following before you come to the session.

1. Go into Watson Library and browse. Pay attention to signs and where services and collections are located (i.e. service desk, reserves, microfilm and microfilm readers, collections, photocopiers, overflow shelves, periodicals, stacks, quiet study spaces, reference, etc.) are located. Walk through the stacks to get a sense of how the library is physically structured and collections organized.
2. Explore the [KU Libraries website](#). Familiarize yourself with the layout, the services, research tools, and how they are organized.
3. Design a model, concept map, flowchart or other schematic which demonstrates that you understand the physical layout, the services, and collections that are available in Watson Library. Bring this to class on August 31, in 419 Watson Library.
